









Chuck Close is a famous artist who paints realistic portraits of faces





One of his most famous works is of himself





2. At a young age he decided to pursue an art career
3. The majority of his works are massive-scale photorealistic or hyperrealistic portraits with an average size of 9 x 7 ft

4. One of the popular beliefs why <sup>more</sup> Close paints faces is because he suffers from prosopagnosia, commonly known as face blindness.

5. Then on December 7, 1988 tragedy struck, Chuck Close had a seizure and suffered a spinal artery collapse, leaving him paralyzed from the neck down, leaving him condemned to a wheelchair for the <sup>rest of</sup> his life.
6. To this day he uses a specialized brace to paint
7. Close has made <sup>and exhibited in public</sup> many paintings in his lifetime most starring strangers, but some are of movie stars and even political figures.
